**C**HEAP, Cheape. The Cheapes of Sauchie, Stirlingshire, are an old family, and so are the Cheaps of Mawhill near Kinross. William Chaip was merchant burgess of Perth, 1510, Johannes Chaip was chaplain of Scone, 1524, George Chaip bailie of Linlithgow, 1536, and Alexander Chaip or Chop held land in Inverbervie, 1616. William Cheape in Hillside, 1666, Anna Cheap in Newtown of Hountintour, 1688 (*Dunkeld*), and Mr. Henri Cheap of Ormistoune, 1698.
