A shield divided per fess silver and green with a stag proper between three trefoils counterchanged.

Cia'll agos neart (Reason and power).

**C**ONNAL, Connell, Connel, Connall. Modern for Congal or Congual. The last form is the name of an old West country (Stirlinshire) family. Cutbert Connell was a voter in the parish of Qwilton (now Coylton), 1513. Robert Connal was retoured heir of Patrick Connall de Greyngill in parish of Beith, 1647. Old french Gilleconal.
